2. Entry is open to all schools that have a valid membership of the SunSmart Schools Program by closing date - 1st March 2012.
3. One entry only per school.

7. The winning entry will be announced 2nd of March 2012. The winning school will be notified by telephone.
8. The Cancer Council WA's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. Money is strictly to be spent on shade provision within the winning school (natural, portable or permanent shade). Cancer Council WA reserves the right to view documentation prior to releasing the funds.
10. Any ancillary costs associated with redeeming the funds are not included.
11. Participants consent to the Cancer Council WA using the school's entry (or part there of), in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting the SunSmart message.
12. Cancer Council WA reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law (a) to disqualify any entrant; or (b) to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the competition.
13. All costs associated with applying for or using the funds are the entrant's responsibility.
