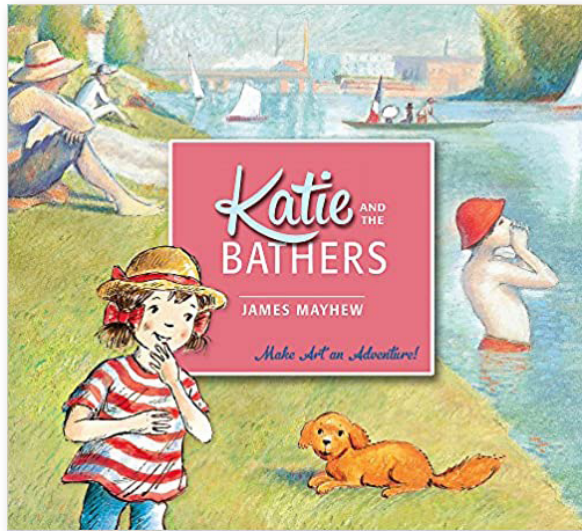


SunSmart Literature Activity Sheet.

Katie and the Bathers, James Mayhew



On a hot, sunny day, a painting of some bathers in a cool river proves too tempting for Katie, and so she dives straight into the picture! But Katie doesn't just cause a splash - she causes a flood! Paddling with new friends might be fun, but how will Katie stop the water pouring into the gallery?

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SunSmart Bathers

Design a pair of SunSmart bathers for both boys and girls to wear to protect them from ultraviolet radiation (UVR).

Paper Plate Umbrella Craft

Umbrellas provide shade from the sun and were used in one of the paintings in the story. Make an umbrella using a paper plate cut in half. Decorate it with stickers, crayons and marker pens.

Art Project

Similar to the paintings in the story, paint or draw a picture showing a scene at the beach or by the river that portrays SunSmart behaviours. Remember slip, slop, slap, seek and slide.
